TRAINING OF VOLUNTEERS ON SEARCH & RESCUE AT DISTRICT & SUB-DISTRICT LEVEL

1st to 3rd week of February 2017

BACKGROUND:

The volunteers engaged with the above programme will be trained on the Basic Search and Rescue techniques and first aid. The training will be organised with the help of locally available resource persons in each district (Fire & ES trainer, NDRF positioned in the district, Civil Defence Staffs, Red Cross etc.). The Development of Volunteers Programme for Disaster Management and this training will roll down in districts simultaneously.

The target group will be the existing Ex-Servicemen of Sainik Welfare Organization at each district, Red Cross Society volunteers, selected VDP of the districts, Civil Defence Volunteers and interested students of recently concluded College Mock Drill (NSS/NCC Volunteers). The maximum intake of each programme will be 50-60 nos. of personnel/volunteers. A total 33 training programme will be held at all district headquarters of Assam.

TRAINING MODULE:

TIME TIMEFRAME: 1st to 3rd week of February 2017

Districts to be covered: All 33 districts of Assam.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION OF VOLUNTEERS:

- The selected Volunteers for the Training of Search & Rescue should be of age group between 19-35 years of age and minimum matriculate and domicile of the concerned districts.
- Total 50 number of volunteers will be selected from each district so that, it represents all parts of the district.
- The Volunteers will be selected from organization like Sainik Welfare Organization, Local NGOs, NSS/NYK/NCC, Civil Defence Volunteers & Selected VDP personnel etc.
- The NCC/NSS volunteers should be from the 1st year of college students, so that they can be present in the college for three years for rendering the service.
- The list & details of volunteers trained will be maintained by respective DDMA for utilizing their services in the district as and when required. Further, they will be enrolled to an online volunteer management system.
- Volunteers will be deployed by the concerned DDMA for disaster response, disaster risk reduction works and any awareness programme conducted by the DDMA. Further, they will at no circumstances be deployed for non-disaster management activities.
